Literacy Activity for (1-2 Years)

Name of the Activity - Sings Rhymes & Stacking



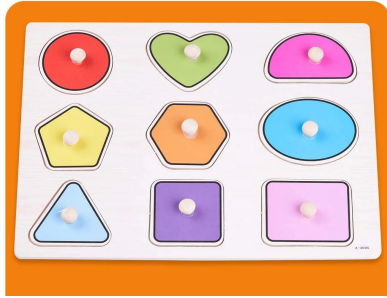
Description: Children at this age can sit & also starts walking. They get attracted towards music or familiar sounds. Singing rhymes, make them feel happy. Different color stacking objects can used as kids love stacking them, knocking them down & building all sorts of structures.

Objective: Singing rhymes to infants is a fun and engaging activity. With stacking we can introduce different colors to them.

Literacy Activity for (2-3 Years)

Name of the Activity - Simple puzzles & Introduce books

WOODEN PEG PUZZLES FOR TODDLERS

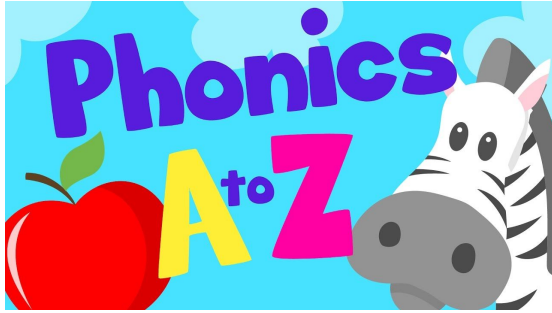


Description: Introduce simple puzzles that have 2-4 pieces. Introducing colorful & eye catching or touch & feel books draw toddlers attention.

Objective: Simple puzzles help the children to develop problem solving & Cognitive skills. Introducing books helps kids to concentrate, look at pictures & try to recognize. It also helps in early reading habit.

Literacy Activity for (3-4 Years)

Name of the Activity - Phonic Sounds & Freeze & Dance



Description: In this age kids understand instructions very well. We can introduce them phonic sounds like letter “c”. Can keep objects or soft toys in the class that start from letter “c” like cat, circle shaped cutout, cup etc. Sand tracing help kids to remember.

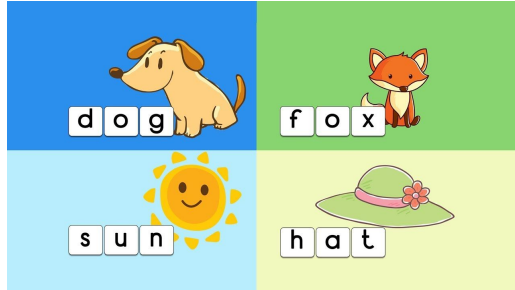
Can play a jolly phonic song of letter “c” & ask kids to stop when music stops. Educator can stop the music where word starting from letter “c” comes. It’s a freeze & dance activity

Objective: Introduction of phonics help children to have better Listening, Reading & Writing skills.

Dance & Freeze activity is a fun way to get them moving and work on listening skills.

Literacy Activity for (4-5 Years)

Name of the Activity - Introduction of three letter words & Spy in nature



Description: By this age children can read all alphabets & recognize all phonic sounds. Show them colorful flash cards with three letter words & point to the picture and say the word. Can ask kids to say together.

Take children outdoors and play a game of I Spy. Can ask children to find objects of different colors, shapes, or sizes around them.



Objective: Three letter words help children to learn vocabulary. Repetition of these word help kids in long run. Outdoor play will in crease there observation skills & get them close to the nature.

Literacy Activity for (5-6 Years)

Name of the Activity - Writing letters (Small Case) & Making sentences



Description: Writing is introduced by this age. Children learn how to hold a pencil & write small letter alphabets. We can give them chalk & slate to start with.

Have a small story session with kids. Once finish ask children about the story. Tell them to make small sentences with any words used in the story.

Objective: Writing help kids to develop fine motor skills & cognitive skills.

Making sentences on their own will enhance their thinking ability. It also boosts creativity & imagination.
